Their career aspirations, job experience and skills will be summarized in a profile and assessed. If required, advanced training and short-term occupational qualification will be organised. In their search for employment or a place for vocational training participants not only benefit from the close collaboration between the project partners, they also receive help and counselling regards questions and problems in connection with the work-permit.
